Mr POON enquired about the following:</p> <p>(a) the major factors to be considered when reviewing the charging levels after three years of implementation of MSW charging, if the Bill was passed;</p> <p>(b) how the Administration would address the concerns of property management companies over the potential conflicts between them and residents related to the depositing of non-compliant waste; and</p> <p>(c) the staffing arrangements for the outreaching teams to be formed, including whether the posts concerned would be created on a permanent basis.</p>

Mr POON sought clarification on the conditions that should be fulfilled in order for frontline cleaning staff employed by property management companies ("PMCs") to resort to the defence under the proposed section 20Q(1)(b) of Cap. 354, including whether they would need to maintain documentation (e.g. written instructions from their employers) to prove that they acted on their employers' instructions.</p>
20190430	<p>3. Mr POON's enquiry and Administration's clarification on the capacities of DBs to be sold under the proposed charging scheme.</p> <p>4. Mr POON and Mr HUI asked about the mechanism for the review and adjustment of the charging level, factors to be considered during the review, and whether a downward adjustment to the charging level was possible.</p>
