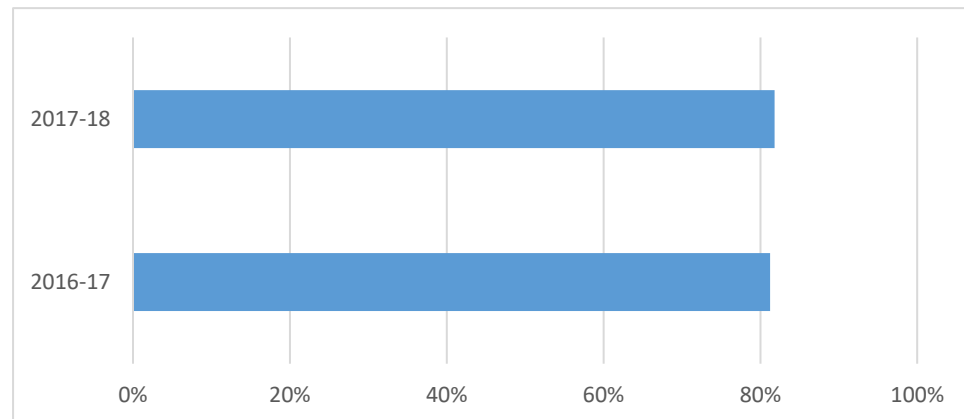

Referring to paragraph 2 of LC Paper No. CB(1)166/17-18(02), Mr WONG enquired under what circumstances would AFCD consider further verifying the certificate with the exporting country or the CITES Secretariat and/or conduct radiocarbon dating for the ivory. He expressed concern that the illegal poaching of elephants and illegal export of ivory had adversely affected the livelihood of the innocent traders/practitioners who had been engaging in legal ivory trading all these years.
